

Moonen chooses CMC stabilisers

Dutch superyacht builder Moonen will install Italian manufacturer CMC Marine's Stabilis Electra on a new 25m (82ft) project

Italian yacht stabilisation specialist CMC Marine will supply its Stabilis Electra system to Dutch superyacht yard Moonen for a 25m (82ft) aluminium motoryacht currently in build at 's-Hertogenbosch in the Netherlands.

The order from Moonen is CMC's 20th for electrical stabilisation systems that the Italian company has received from 'shipyards of note' since the system's launch in June 2010. Other yards using CMC's electric stabilisers include Italian superyacht builders Sanlorenzo and Benetti.

Stabilis Electra is currently available in two models catering to boats from 18m-35m (59ft-115ft), but plans are being drawn up for applications on boats above 35m (115ft).

CMC holds an international patent for the electrically actuated Stabilis Electra stabilisation system. Based in Como, northern Italy, CMC also supplies hydraulic stabiliser fins.
